Who are TOEIC Link assessments for?

What does each TOEIC Link skill measure?

TOEIC Link is comprised of four modules (Listening, Reading, Speaking, and Writing), which can be taken together or separately.

Listening

This assessment consists of 30 questions administered across two testing stages: a Routing Module in Stage 1 (17 items) and an Easy or Hard Module in Stage 2 (13 items).

Test takers respond to descriptions, questions and conversations in English in the following task types:

- Photographs
- Question-response
- Conversations and talks
- Talks

Total time: 18 minutes

Reading

This assessment consists of 30 questions administered across two testing stages: a Routing Module in Stage 1 (17 items) and an Easy or Hard Module in Stage 2 (13 items).

Test takers are asked to complete sentences and answer questions about written texts in English in the following task types:

- Incomplete sentences
- Text completion
- Single passages
- Double passages
- Triple passage

Total time: 26 minutes

Speaking

This assessment consists of 11 questions grouped into 3 task types. Test takers are asked to read texts aloud; listen to and repeat sentences; and give opinions.

Task 1: Read a dialogue aloud

Task 2: Listen and repeat

Task 3: Express an opinion

Total time: 10 minutes

Writing

This assessment consists of 6 questions grouped into 4 tasks. Test takers are asked to complete and write sentences; ask for and provide information; and give opinions.

Task 1: Build a sentence

Task 2: Write a brief email

Task 3: Write an extended email

Task 4: Write about your perspective

Total time: 27 minutes

How are the TOEIC Link assessments scored?

TOEIC Link scores are reported on a scale of 0-25 for each individual skill and the overall assessment score. To aid understanding of a candidate's English level, TOEIC Link scores are mapped to Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) levels — from beginner (CEFR A1) to advanced (CEFR C1).

TOEIC Link results are delivered immediately for Listening and Reading modules and within 48 hours for Speaking and Writing modules.
